Notice to Operators

New Phone Number for Immediate Verbal Reporting (902) 496-4444

Background

The CNSOPB has put in place a new 24-hour phone number (902) 496-4444 for reporting offshore emergencies and for "Immediate Verbal Notification" in accordance with the "Incident Reporting and Investigation Guidelines".

Operators are urged to begin using this new reporting number, which is available for immediate use. Operators are expected to update their reporting procedures by August 1, 2014 to reflect this change.

This new reporting number replaces (902) 422-5588 which will continue to serve as the main number for routine contact with the CNSOPB. Until August 1, 2014, the main number will continue to serve as a back-up for the new reporting number.

What to expect when you call (902) 496-4444

- Your call will be answered by the 24-hour call-service operator
- The operator will take your name, phone number, and company
- The operator will contact the assigned CNSOPB Duty Officer who will return your call
- The Duty Officer will call you and will be prepared to receive your report
