Dear Christine Bonnell-Eisnor:

Please consider this letter a formal request from Natural Resources Canada and the Nova Scotia Department of Energy to the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Energy Regulator to host the maps and shapefile data related to the jointly designated Wind Energy Areas (WEAs). The designation of the WEAs is a key planning step in the land tenure process for offshore wind development and provides the basis for future Calls for Bids and the development of the offshore wind sector in Nova Scotia.

WEAs are large contiguous portions of the Canada-Nova Scotia offshore that have been deemed potentially suitable for offshore wind energy development and are intended to provide clarity and certainty to industry, stakeholders, and Indigenous groups on priority areas for future development. As you know, the designated WEAs build off the potential development areas identified in the Nova Scotia Regional Assessment's final report and were subject to further analysis and a public comment period in spring 2025.

As the lead and lifecycle regulator of offshore renewable energy in the Canada-Nova Scotia offshore area, the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Energy Regulator is best placed to host this information and to make it publicly available for all interested parties. Parcels within one or more of these WEAs will be subject to future Calls for Bids, the first of which is to be held in 2025, administered by the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Energy Regulator.

We have directed our officials to provide you with any necessary information and support.
