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Executive Summary

To date, the Sable Project has resulted in a direct infusion of \$934.3 million into the Nova Scotian economy and over \$1.3 billion into the Canadian economy.

In 2001, Nova Scotia captured over 50% of the year's expenditures and over 80% of the Sable Project labour.

Throughout the year 2001, the Sable Project continued to aid in the development of a sustainable and successful industry in Nova Scotia. Initiatives to aid in reaching this goal included investments in community education and participation, research and development, training, technology transfer and continued support of our diversity and inclusion programs. During the fourth

quarter alone, over \$327 thousand was invested in research and development (R&D) in Nova Scotia. This brings the annual 2001 total to over \$2 million, and the total cumulative R&D investment in Nova Scotia to nearly \$20 million.

Focus also continued on skills development in Nova Scotia during this year with over \$5 million invested in training. The effort included the training of Project employees, training initiatives of major contractors, community training investments and co-op student programs. **Of particular note is the more than \$1.5 million that has been invested in 226 co-op/work placements opportunities since the Project's inception.**

1.0 Introduction

The Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits 2001 Annual Report for the Sable Project is hereby submitted to the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board (CNSOPB) in accordance with the requirements under Section 2.6 and Condition #9 of the Sable Offshore Energy Project Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board Benefits Plan Decision Report dated December 3, 1997 (for implementation effective December 30, 1997).

This report addresses Sable Project benefits activities for the period January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2001, and has been prepared and submitted by ExxonMobil Canada Properties (ExxonMobil) as the Sable Project operator.

2.0 Operations/Project Update

2.1 Operations

2001 marked the second full year of production of the Sable Project, Nova Scotia's first offshore natural gas project. Currently, production is averaging 550 million cubic feet of natural gas and 20,000 barrels of natural gas liquids every day. 2001 saw records set for gas sales.

In addition to a brief planned shutdown during the second quarter to allow completion of periodic maintenance, several mini-projects were undertaken, including:

- Commissioning of the turbo-expander at Goldboro and the deepcut section of the process;
- Natural gas liquids coalescing and propane drying project;
- Poly and wax pigging program on the 26-inch line; and
- Intelligent pig run on the 26-inch line.

As part of ongoing operations, the Venture V-2 and the Thebaud T-6 wells were drilled.

On February 1, 2002, ExxonMobil became the operator of the Sable Project. The owners of the offshore project facilities, excluding the 26 inch subsea pipeline are ExxonMobil Canada Properties, Shell Canada Limited, Imperial Oil Resources, Emera Offshore Incorporated and Mosbacher Operating Limited.

The owners of the onshore facilities and 26 inch subsea pipeline are ExxonMobil Canada Properties, Shell Canada Limited, Imperial Oil Resources and Mosbacher Operating Limited.

2.2 Project

In addition to ongoing operations, 2001 saw preliminary engineering and the commencement of detailed engineering for Alma, the first of the Tier II fields (Alma, South Venture and Glenelg). As part of that detailed engineering, procurement for Tier II activity began resulting in a number of packages being developed and awarded in 2001.



3.0 Canada-Nova Scotia Content

3.1 Expenditure Content

During 2001, Nova Scotia and the rest of Canada were successful in the competitive bidding process. For the year 2001, a total of \$276.1 million was spent on the project. Of that, Nova Scotia captured over half, at \$139.1 million (50.4%). Other Canadian provinces and territories accounted for \$47.1 million (17.1%) and less than one third was spent outside of Canada at \$89.9 million (32.5%).

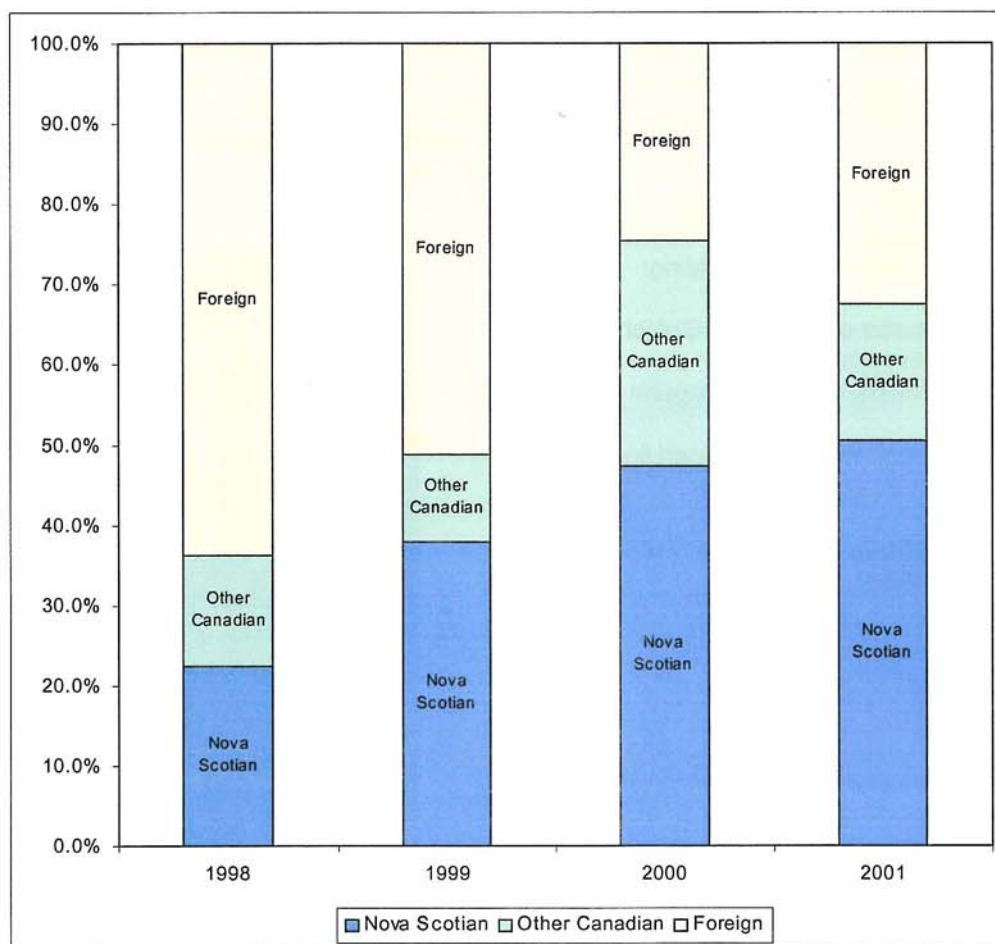

Cumulative expenditures as at December 31, 2001 were \$934.3 million for Nova Scotia, \$432.2 million for Other Canadian provinces and territories and \$1,324.6 million for non-Canadian locations.

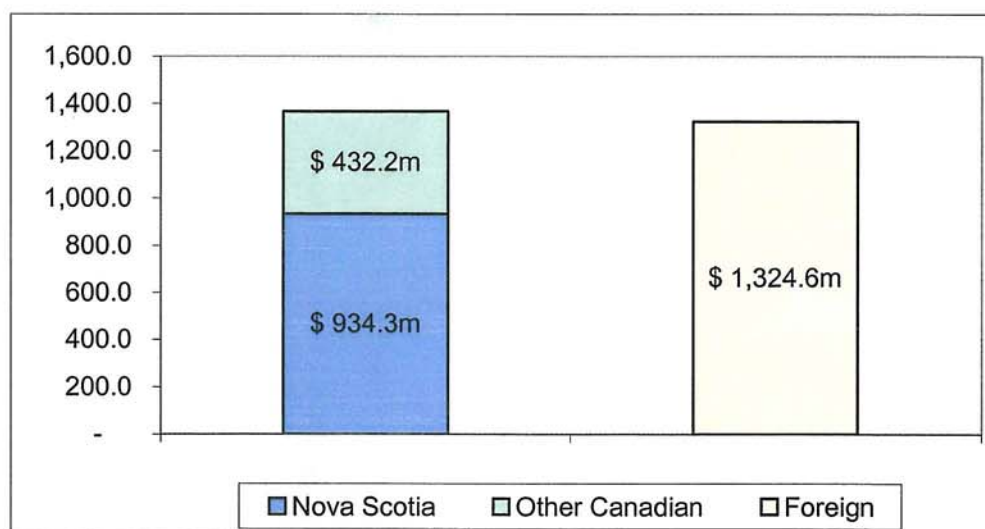
Percentage of Project Expenditures

3.2 Labour Content

In 2001, the Sable Project registered 1.66 million person hours of which 81.77% were Nova Scotian, 10.04% were Other Canadian and 8.19% were Foreign.

During the fourth quarter of 2001, the Project registered over 470,000 person hours. The cumulative person hours for the Sable Project as at December 31, 2001 totaled over 17.1 million. Of the 17.1 million, over 9.7 million, or 56.86%, were Nova Scotian and over 1.9 million were Other Canadian, or 11.11%.

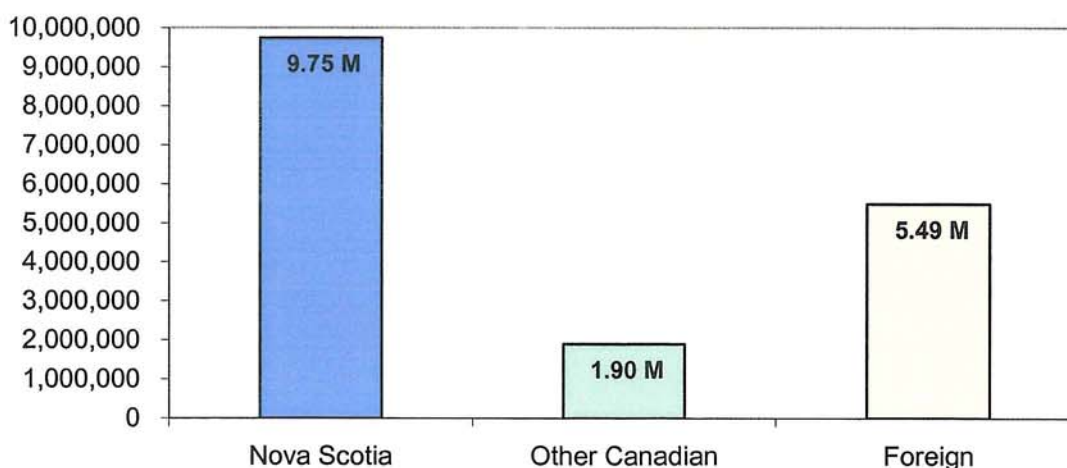

3.3 Employment Headcount

The overall employment headcount at the end of 2001 was 681. These figures presented below include those individuals working directly on the Sable Project and those working for major contractors. 3.4 Residency of New Hires/Secondees

The total number of New Hires/Secondees reported for the Sable Project and its major contractors during the fourth quarter of 2001 was 87. Approximately 84% of new hires/secondees during this period consisted of individuals resident in Nova Scotia or Other Canadian locations at the time of hire/secondment.

For the year 2001, there were a total of 620 new hires to the Sable Project, of which over 81% were resident in Nova Scotia or Other Canadian locations at the time of hire/secondment.

4.0 Aiding in the Development of a Sustainable Industry in Nova Scotia

During 2001, initiatives related to developing and supporting a viable and increasingly sustainable oil and gas industry in Nova Scotia continued to be undertaken. These initiatives have been divided into four core areas:

- Research and Development
- Training and Education
- Technology Transfer
- Diversity and Inclusion

4.1 Research and Development

During 2001, Sable Project owner companies and contractors continued to build progressive and long-term relationships with the Nova Scotia research and development (R&D) community.

Atlantic Canada Petroleum Institute (ACPI)

Support for the Atlantic Canada Petroleum Institute continued throughout the year including financial aid and participation on committees and in peer review sessions.

R&D Investments

In the fourth quarter, 2001 over, \$327,000 was invested in research and development. For the year 2001, over \$2.5 million was spent on Research and Development initiatives, bringing the cumulative R&D investments total at the end of the fourth quarter, 2001 to nearly \$20 million. Co-op/ Work Placements

As part of a continued recognition that education of future employees is a key component of building a sustainable oil and gas industry in Nova Scotia, support for co-op and work placement programs continued. Our contractors have also been strong supporters of co-op programs.

During the fourth quarter, there were 10 new co-op and work placement opportunities for students of varied disciplines. The total cost of hosting these students plus existing students during the fourth quarter of 2001 was over \$189,000.

Since the beginning of 1998, in excess of \$1.5 million has been invested in 226 co-op/work placement opportunities. A detailed table of co-op/work placements for 2001 is included as Appendix 4. 4.3 Technology Transfer

Technology transfer is a vital aspect of developing a sustainable oil and gas industry in Nova Scotia. Technology transfer is equipment or a type of training that reflects knowledge, expertise or skills being transferred to Nova Scotia or other parts of Canada.

During the fourth quarter of 2001, expenditures related to technology transfer accounted for over \$264,000, and over \$4.6 million was invested in technology transfer during the year 2001. The total cumulative expenditures related to technology transfer are over \$13.6 million as of December 31, 2001.

Appendix 5 details technology transfer during 2001. The following table shows historic technology transfer investments.

Engineering expertise being transferred to Nova Scotia through Kvaerner SNC-Lavalin Offshore comprised a large portion of the technology transfer that occurred during 2001.

5.0 Community Education and Participation

Community Investment Program

During 2001, the Sable Community Investment Program continued to be very active in the provision of financial support to charitable organizations in Nova Scotia which focus on education, community support, arts and culture and social welfare. This program targets the Project's key geographical areas of Guysborough and Antigonish counties, the Straight Area and the Greater Halifax area.

For 2001, over \$460,000 was contributed to a number of organizations across Nova Scotia including:

Halifax Metro United Way

ExxonMobil Canada raised a record \$183,000 for the Halifax Metro United Way, making it one of the most successful corporate campaigns in the city. The enthusiastic month-long campaign was packed with fund-raising and fun-raising events, all organized by employees and contractors. Through pledges and events we raised \$97,000, which was matched by ExxonMobil Canada.

Techsploration

Sable Offshore Energy, and now ExxonMobil Canada, has supported the Techsploration program for the last four years. The program is having tremendous success in exposing young women to future careers in trades, technologies and sciences - all areas of high interest to the oil and gas industry. Young women from eight high schools in the region participate in the program every year. ExxonMobil Canada female employees volunteer as role models.

Granville Green Outdoor Concert Series

ExxonMobil Canada is a strong supporter of Granville Green - a series of free outdoor concerts held each Sunday in July and August at the Port Hawkesbury waterfront bandshell. ExxonMobil Canada is very proud to present the festival's Youth Showcase which profiles youth artists from Guysborough, Antigonish and Port Hawkesbury.

RCMP - Drug Awareness Resistance Education

ExxonMobil Canada is a major sponsor of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Drug Awareness Resistance Education (DARE) program in Nova Scotia. The program is designed to teach youth the necessary information to defend themselves against drug abuse and to help students make the best life choices.

Stan Rogers Festival

ExxonMobil Canada has supported this unique folk festival for the past five years through Sable Offshore Energy, the prime corporate sponsor. The festival is held every year in Canso over the first or second weekend in July. Thousands of people flock to the site for the three-day event from all across the continent.

Adopt-A-School Program

ExxonMobil Canada is in the process of forming a special business-education partnership with a Halifax inner-city school - Joseph Howe Public School. Through this partnership, ExxonMobil Canada will provide a number of resources to this very deserving primary school.

An additional \$445,600 was invested by owner companies in community initiatives resulting in total community investments in excess of \$909,000 during 2001.

Community Information Program

The Community Liaison team coordinated a number of tours of the Goldboro gas plant for a variety of community groups during 2001. As well, two open houses were held and the team met regularly with municipal council as well as the Sable Safety Committee and the Sable Community Advisory Committee.

In addition, the Project continued to respond to an average of four web-based inquiries every day during 2001.
