**2002 Annual Report
Canada – Nova Scotia Benefits**



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Executive Summary

To date, the Sable Project has resulted in over \$1.76 billion being invested into the Nova Scotian economy and over \$2.73 billion into the Canadian economy. In addition, Nova Scotia captured over 59.1% of the total \$439.9 million expenditures in 2002.

Throughout 2002, the Sable Project continued to assist with development of a gas industry in Nova Scotia. Initiatives to aid in reaching this goal included investments in community education, research and development, training, technology transfer and continued support of diversity and inclusion programs. During the Fourth Quarter of 2002 alone, over \$656 thousand was invested in research and development in Nova Scotia, bringing the 2002 total to over \$881 thousand. The total cumulative research and development investment in Nova Scotia at the end of 2002, as a result of the Sable Project, is over \$20.8 million.

Focus also continued on skills development in Nova Scotia during 2002 with more than \$4.0 million invested in training and education. Efforts included the training of Project employees, training initiatives of major contractors, community training investments and co-op student programs. **Of particular note is the more than \$2.0 million that has been invested in 299 co-op/work placements related to the Sable Project since the Project began.**

1.0 Introduction

The Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits 2002 Annual Report for the Sable Project is hereby submitted to the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board (CNSOPB) in accordance with the requirements under Section 2.6 and Condition #9 of the Sable Offshore Energy Project Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board Benefits Plan Decision Report dated December 3, 1997 (for implementation effective December 30, 1997).

This report addresses Sable Project benefits activities for the period January 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002, and has been prepared and submitted by ExxonMobil Canada Properties (ExxonMobil) as the Sable Project operator.

2.0 Operations/Tier II Development Update

2.1 Operations

The year 2002 marked the third full year of production for the Sable Project. Currently, daily production is averaging over 518.1 million cubic feet of natural gas and over 16,580 barrels of natural gas liquids. In January of 2002, the project had its highest monthly average of sales gas, at 655.0 million cubic feet per day and January 8, 2002 had the highest daily production of over 664.9 million cubic feet.

The installation of a supplementary sales gas cooler in Goldboro, started during the Second Quarter of 2002, was completed and commissioned for use in the Third Quarter of 2002.

Construction of two 200m³ mono-ethylene glycol (MEG) storage tanks began in Goldboro during the Second Quarter, and were commissioned in the Fourth Quarter of 2002.

In the Third Quarter, there was a successful workover of Thebaud 5 and 6 wells. Also, continued drilling and completion of the Venture 6 well in the Third Quarter was completed in the Fourth Quarter of 2002.

An emergency power stand-by generator was commissioned in Point Tupper and recoating of the Thebaud and Venture helidecks was completed in the Fourth Quarter of 2002.

A new Natural Gas Liquids production record was established in December, 2002 and the highest monthly 'up-time' was established in the Fourth Quarter (November 2002).

2.2 Tier II Development

Alma

The year 2002 saw the engineering and letting of most contracts for the Alma field development. Fabrication of the Alma jacket and topsides commenced and Saipem S.p.A. completed installation of the subsea pipeline from the Alma field to Thebaud. Lastly, commissioning activities commenced in 2002 in preparation for first gas in 2003.

South Venture

Both preliminary and front-end engineering for South Venture took place in 2002. Detailed engineering commenced in 2002. In addition, many packages were awarded including the topsides fabrication package to the Halifax-based Irving Shipbuilding Incorporated.

Compression

Preliminary engineering and front-end engineering for compression was substantially completed during 2002 in preparation for the issuance of the "invitation to tender."

3.0 Canada-Nova Scotia Economic Impact

The Sable Project has had a significant positive impact on the Canadian economy, and in particular, the economy of Nova Scotia. Expenditures below will be shown using two methodologies, the *Canada General Standards Board Method* adopted by the Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board and the *Cash Flow Method* used by many significant Nova Scotia industries (e.g. tourism, fishing) to illustrate the total "Flow of Cash" through the economy. In addition to expenditures, three other indicators of economic impact, (person hours, headcount and new hires) are also reported.

3.1 Expenditures

Canada General Standards Board (CGSB) Method

During 2002, Nova Scotia and the rest of Canada continued to be successful in the competitive bidding process. For the year 2002, a total of \$439.9 million was spent on the Project. Of that, Nova Scotia captured 40.2% of the total, at \$176.7 million according to the CGSB methodology. Other Canadian provinces and territories accounted for \$100.6 million (22.8%) and just under 37.0% was spent outside of Canada at \$162.6 million.

Cumulative expenditures as at December 31, 2002 were \$1,142.1 million for Nova Scotia, \$546.3 million for Other Canadian provinces and territories and \$1,497.1 million for non-Canadian locations.

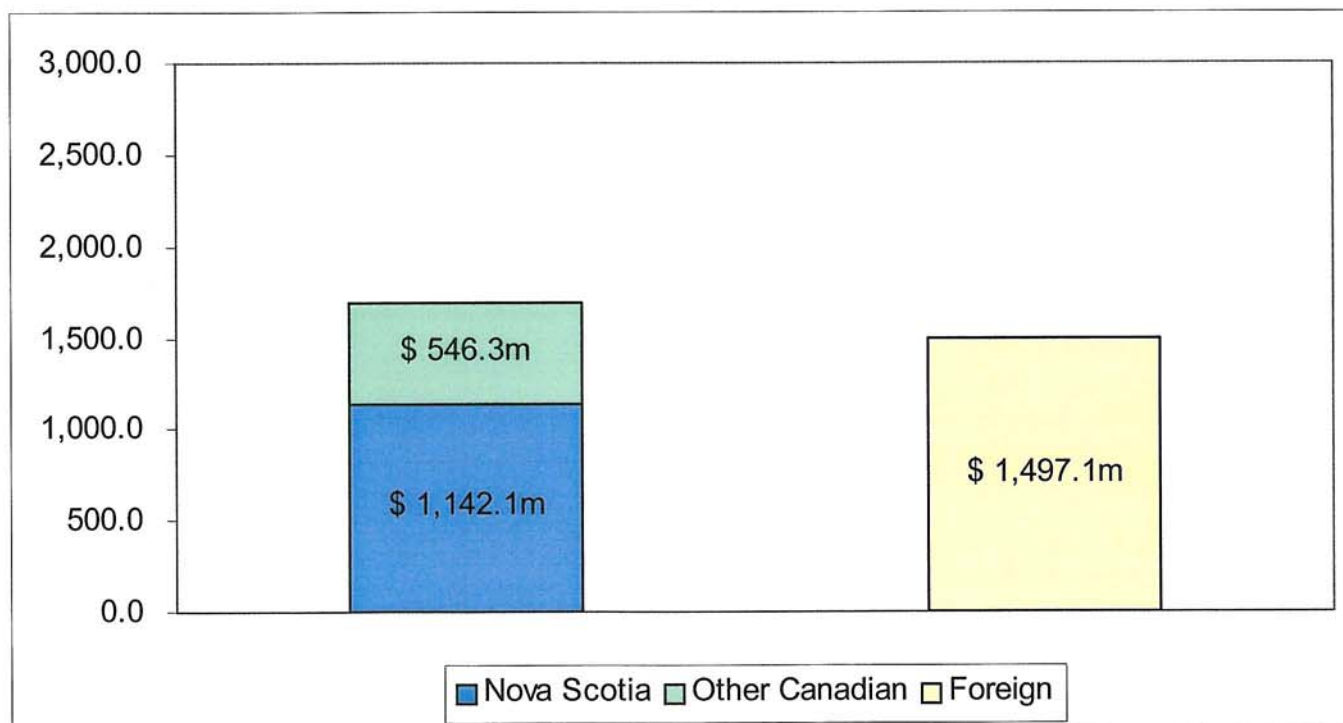
Using CGSB, Nova Scotia content exceeded the \$1 Billion mark in the First Quarter of 2002.

Cash Flow Methodology

Using the Cash Flow methodology, well over half of the total \$439.9 million of expenditures in 2002 went to Nova Scotia at \$260.1 million or 59.1%. Furthermore, total Canadian (Nova Scotia and Other Canadian) made up over 92.3% of the total expenditures for 2002 at \$406.2 million. Monies flowing outside of Canada made up less than 7.7% of the total at \$33.7 million.

Cumulatively, a new milestone was arrived at when the total expenditures for the Project exceeded the \$3 billion mark in the Third Quarter of 2002. Using the Cash Flow methodology, Nova Scotia captured well over half of the almost \$3.2 billion expenditure at the end of the Fourth Quarter at over \$1.7 billion or 55.3%. Furthermore, Other Canadian provinces and territories captured over \$0.97

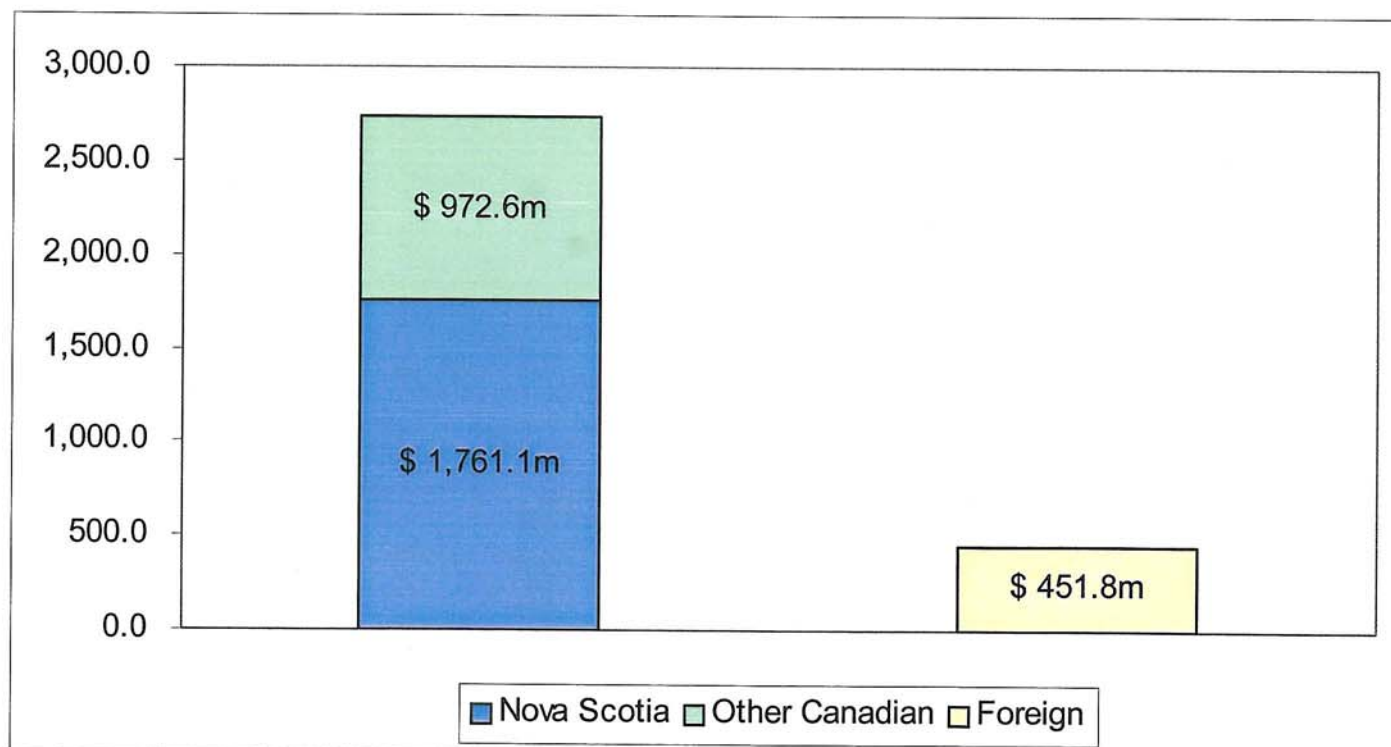
billion of the total, or just over 30.5%, bringing the total Canadian (Nova Scotian and Other Canadian) participation in the project to over \$2.73 billion, or 85.8%. Cash flowing outside of Canada made up just over \$0.45 billion, or less than 14.2%.

Nova Scotia companies won \$260.1 million worth of work in 2002.

Using the Cash Flow Methodology, total Canadian content (Nova Scotia and Other Canadian) exceeds 85.8% of the over \$3.2 Billion in total cumulative Project expenditures.

3.2 Person Hours

During the year 2002, the Sable Project provided over 1.8 million hours of employment. Of the 2002 total, almost 1.0 million hours were provided to Nova Scotians, or almost 54.2%. Over 280,000 hours of employment were provided to Other Canadians, or almost 15.7%, and less than 550,000 hours were Foreign, or just over 30.1%.

Cumulatively, Nova Scotia maintains its dominance in the provision of labour to the Sable Project providing 10.73 million hours of employment, or 56.6% of the total. Other Canadians, as of December 31, 2002, were provided 2.19 million hours of employment, or 11.5% and labour from outside of Canada accounted for less than 31.9% of the total, or 6.04 million hours.

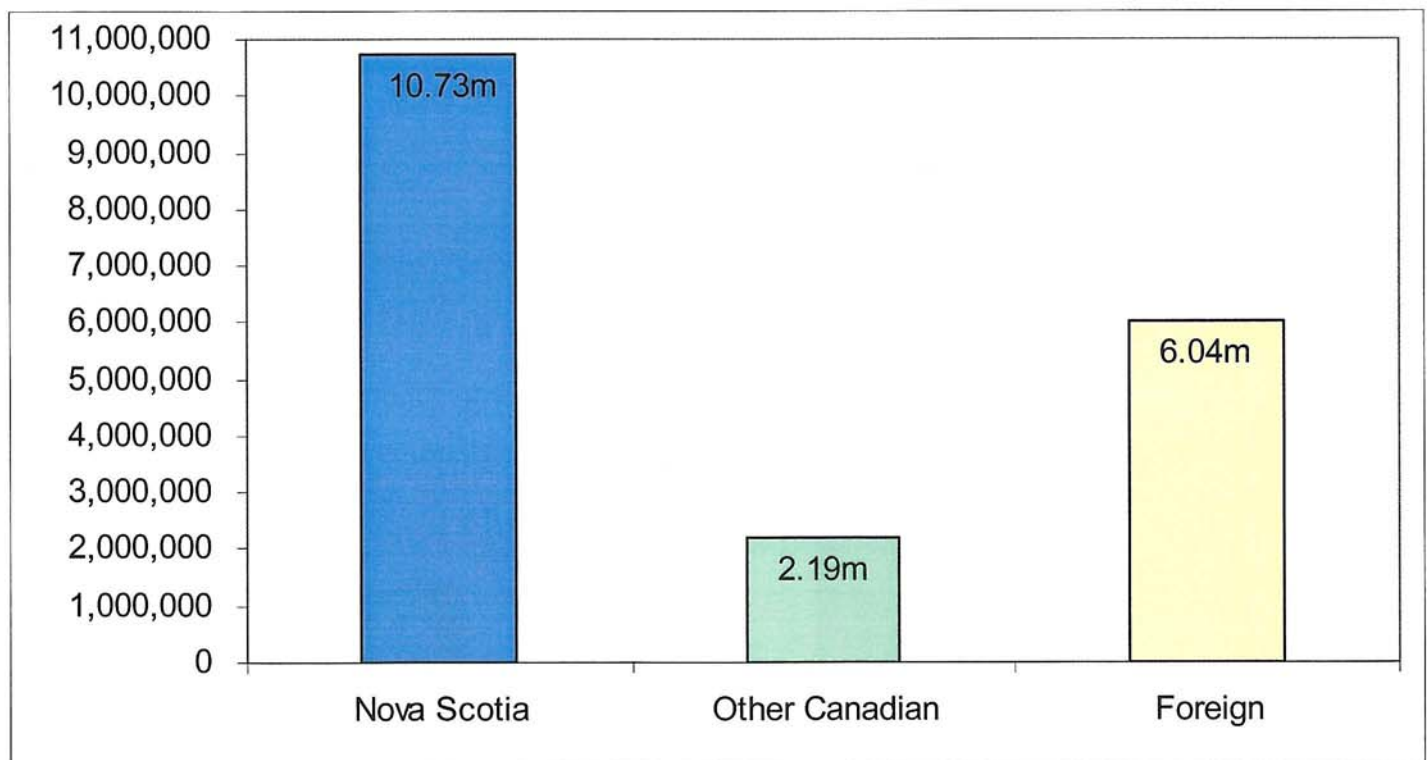

During the Second Quarter of 2002, the Project exceeded the milestone of providing over 10 million hours of employment to Nova Scotians.

Also, a significant achievement was realized in the year 2002 during the Second Quarter, when cumulatively, the Project had provided in excess of 10 million hours of employment in Nova Scotia for the first time.

3.3 Employment Headcount

The overall employment headcount as at December 31, 2002 was 1,290. The figures presented below include those individuals working directly on the Sable Project and those working for major contractors. Of the 1,290 people working on the Sable Project on December 31, 2002, 917 (71.1%) were working in Nova Scotia. The following table shows headcounts of 2000, 2001 and 2002, to date.

3.4 Residency of New Hires/Secondees

The total number of New Hires/Secondees reported for the Sable Project and its major contractors during the Fourth Quarter of 2002 was 208.

4.0 Aiding in the Development of a Sustainable Industry in Nova Scotia

During 2002, initiatives related to developing and supporting a viable and increasingly sustainable gas industry in Nova Scotia continued to be undertaken. These initiatives have been divided into four core areas:

- Research and Development
- Training and Education
- Technology Transfer
- Diversity and Inclusion

Please note: Items in Section 4.0 may also be reported by ExxonMobil and affiliates in other reports.

4.1 Research and Development

In the Fourth Quarter of 2002, over \$656,000 was invested in Nova Scotia in research and development by ExxonMobil, its partners and contractors, bringing the total for 2002 to over \$881,000. The cumulative investment in

research and development from the Sable Project is over \$20.8 million. Please see the table below for historic research and development investments and see Appendix 6 for a detailed list of research and development investments during the year 2002.

4.2 Training and Education

During 2002, emphasis continued to be placed on relevant skill development in Nova Scotia related to the oil and gas industry. In addition to expenditures made on employee training, investments in community training and educational programs were also made.

Production Operations Training Capacity Development

Nova Scotia has put forth significant effort to develop training expertise that is supportive of the oil and gas industry. The initial hope of many educational and training institutes in Nova Scotia has been to support the needs in Nova Scotia. In addition to meeting the local needs, these institutes also wish to export this expertise. An important milestone related to this goal occurred in 2002. Thirteen employees from Esso Angola, ExxonMobil's subsidiary in Angola, enrolled at the University College of Cape Breton (UCCB) and the Nova Scotia Community College (NSCC) Marconi Campus (9 in Production Operations and 4 in Electrical Technician). These students came because of a strategic partnership between ExxonMobil and UCCB/NSCC. In addition to the students enrolled at UCCB/NSCC, three other ExxonMobil employees from Angola trained at the Goldboro gas plant under the mentorship of Nova Scotia tradespeople. This training began in September 2002 and will take place over an 18 month period allowing the students to hone their instrumentation skills and become knowledgeable in the safe work practices and procedures of ExxonMobil.

Training and education investments for the Fourth Quarter of 2002 totaled over \$996 thousand.

Co-op/Work Placements

As part of a continued recognition that education of future employees is a key component of building a sustainable oil and gas industry in Nova Scotia, support for co-op and work placement programs continued throughout 2002. As well, our contractors have also been strong supporters of co-op programs.

During the Fourth Quarter of 2002, there were 10 co-op and work placement opportunities for students of varied disciplines. The total cost of hosting these students and existing students during the Fourth Quarter of 2002 was in excess of \$142,000.

For 2002, a total of 73 co-op positions were hosted by ExxonMobil and our contractors, with a total cost for the year of \$572,000. Since the beginning of 1998, in excess of \$2.0 million has been invested in 299 co-op/work placement opportunities. A detailed table of co-op/work placements for the year 2002 is included as Appendix 7. The following table shows the historic investments in co-op/work placement programs.

Note: The total number of placements for the fourth quarter, 2002 does not include 6 co-op/work placements that began their term with ExxonMobil during the third quarter of 2002. The total investment for the fourth quarter includes the investment in these 6 students for October, November and December, 2002.

4.3 Technology Transfer

Technology transfer is a vital aspect of developing a sustainable oil and gas industry in Nova Scotia. Technology transfer is the use of equipment or a type of training that reflects knowledge, expertise or skills being transferred to Nova Scotia or other parts of Canada.

During the Fourth Quarter of 2002, expenditures related to technology transfer accounted for more than \$1.7 million, and the annual 2002 expenditures related to technology transfer were \$4.1 million. Finally, the total cumulative expenditures related to technology transfer exceeded \$17.8 million as of December 31, 2002.

Engineering expertise being transferred to Nova Scotia through Kvaerner SNC-Lavalin Offshore continued to represent a large portion of the technology transfer related to the Sable Project.

4.4 Diversity and Inclusion

Rather, ExxonMobil encourages "voluntary self-identification" which occurs when individuals identify themselves as members of a traditionally underrepresented group on an application/resume and/or proactively to their supervisor/organization, or through other voluntary means.

5.0 Community Education and Participation

During 2002, ExxonMobil Canada (on behalf of the Sable Project owners) continued to be very active in the provision of financial support to charitable organizations in Nova Scotia which focus attention on education, community support, arts and culture, and social welfare. These programs target the Project's key geographical areas of Guysborough and Antigonish counties, the Straight area and the Greater Halifax area.

For 2002, \$337,624 was contributed to a number of organizations across Nova Scotia including:

United Way of Halifax Region

One of the high points of 2002 was the success of the 2002 United Way Corporate Campaign, where contributions by ExxonMobil Canada and fundraising events organized by its staff raised over \$183,000 for the United Way, making it one of the most successful corporate campaigns in the city.

RCMP – Drug Awareness Resistance Education

ExxonMobil Canada is proud to be the principal sponsor of the RCMP's Drug Abuse Resistance Education program in Nova Scotia. The program is designed to provide students in grades five and six with the tools they need to say "no" to drugs. Over 4,000 Nova Scotian students graduated from the program this year. A resolution was passed unanimously by the Nova Scotia House of Assembly recognizing the outstanding work by the RCMP and the ongoing support of ExxonMobil Canada.

Metro Food Bank

For the fifth year, ExxonMobil Canada held a charity golf tournament on Saturday, June 22, to raise funds for the Metro Food Bank. Dozens of sponsors and 144 participants raised over \$32,000 for the Food Bank.
